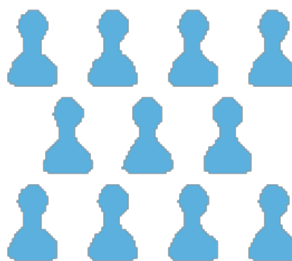

- Explore collaborative technology tools including: iGoogle, Google Docs, Google Reader, Blogger, Twitter and Skype.

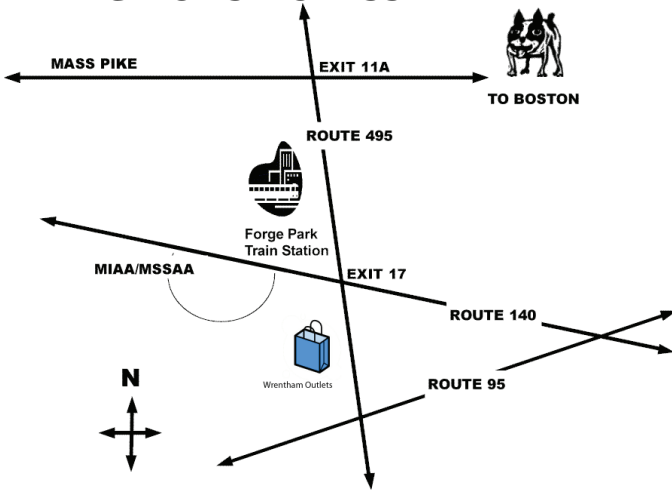
