The teacher is the key element in the educational process. Research shows that over 80% of student success in learning is dependent on the teacher. The teacher is the key to effective classroom management. Behavior management, within the classroom setting, is integral to a teacher’s overall capacity to effectively teach and manage their classroom.
