Setting up and executing a successful classroom management plan requires planning for and attending to nine components of effective classroom management.

The participants will be able to:

- Identify and create a classroom management plan that contain all nine components of effective classroom management
- Develop and implement classroom rules and routines that maximize the level of respectful, on-task behavior and fosters social-emotional development
- Develop and implement a system of positive behavior supports to reinforce respectful, on-task behavior
- Obtain students’ attention at the start of lessons, after group and partner activities, after interruptions, and after student attention has wandered
- Identify and develop the components of effective and respectful student-teacher and student-student relationships including the development of social-emotional skills
- Implement the 11 components of effective group and parent work that insures a high level of student independent, on task behavior

Cynthia Marchand’s career in education has spanned 37 years, 33 of those in the Newton, Massachusetts Public School District. She has served as a teacher, an elementary principal and a Superintendent. As an educational leader, she has focused on refining practice through embedded professional development, consistency of focus, and distributive leadership.

Carol Gregory, M.S. served as a teacher, union president, and vice principal (Brookline Public Schools); middle school principal (Westwood & Northampton Public Schools); Human Resources Director (Lexington Public Schools), and Assistant Superintendent (Wellesley Public Schools) Presentation topics include: *Social and Emotional Learning, The Brain and Learning, Motivation and Intelligence, and Teacher Evaluation*. She co-authored Inducting and Mentoring Teachers New to the District (2015), Low Performing Educators (2019) and Teacher Evaluation That Works (2019).
