The purpose of this course is to provide school administrators with the knowledge and skills necessary to be effective reviewers and instructional leaders of educators who teach English language learners so that our growing population of English language learners (ELLs) can access curriculum, achieve academic success, and contribute their multilingual and multicultural resources as participants and future leaders in the 21st century global economy.

The SEI Administrator Endorsement course consists of 15 hours of face-to-face completed via 5 synchronous sessions and asynchronous (Moodle) modules. In addition to the synchronous and asynchronous components, there is homework, including practice assignments related to the administrators work with staff and students.

The program provides 22.5 PDPs and participants may purchase 1 graduate credit from the Fitchburg State University.

**Kaitlyn Torossion** is a New Teacher Developer for Boston Public Schools. She works with novice teachers, as a Program Supervisor for licensure in the areas of Moderate Disabilities and English as a Second Language. She also provides monthly professional development to part-time New Teacher Developers in Boston.
